

**A RESOLUTION OF THE
COMMISSIONERS COURT OF DENTON COUNTY, TEXAS
CONFIRMING DENTON COUNTY'S INCLUSION IN THE NORTH TEXAS GROUNDWATER
CONSERVATION DISTRICT.**

WHEREAS, Senate Bill 2497 was passed by the 81st Legislature, Regular Session, and signed by the Governor on May 27, 2009, creating the North Texas Groundwater Conservation District ("District"); and

WHEREAS, The District is a groundwater conservation district in Collin, Cook, and Denton Counties created under and essential to accomplish the purposes of Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution ; and

WHEREAS, The District is created to serve a public use and benefit; and


WHEREAS, All of the land and other property included within the boundaries of the District will be benefited by the works and projects that are to be accomplished by the District under the powers conferred by Subtitle H, Title 6, Special District Local Laws Code, Chapter 8856, and by Chapter 36, Water Code; and


WHEREAS, The Denton County Commissioners Court appointed temporary directors on Tuesday, August 4, 2009, and conducted a public hearing to confirm or reject Denton County's inclusion in the District on Tuesday, August 11, 2009;




